he's gentle with the old.

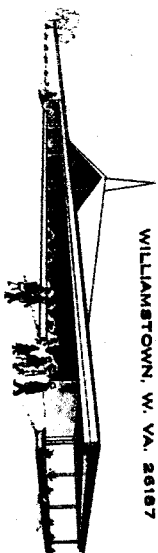
When a man's a man, you will find his friends
