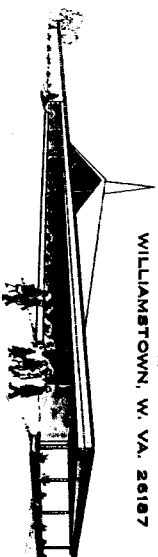

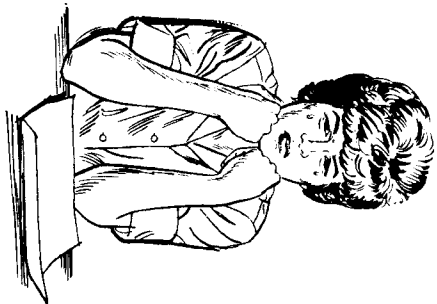
Depressed? Think About This
